Disaster Countermeasures

They're involved in positive activities such as preparing for earthquake damage, emphasizing self-preparedness, and people helping each other when disasters occur.

Environment Beautification

They work hard to beautify the environment through activities such as cleaning up places in the area like roadways and parks.

Recycling Refuse

They participate in activities of recycling limited resources by collecting cans, newspapers, bottles, etc., from all households.

Disaster Training

In preparing for earthquakes and sudden disasters, they conduct disaster training, purchase supplies, etc.



Cultural / Recreational Activities

In order to strive for friendliness among area residents, they hold activities in which anyone can participate, such as physical fitness festivals, cultural festivals and bon-odori festivals.



Garbage Station Management

They do things such as asking cities to set up garbage collection stations for everyone to use, and then keeping the stations clean by having people stand scheduled watches on them.




Activities of Citizens' Associations
